

We (Sight Advice South Lakes) are aware that there are no services outside of South Lakeland and Barrow (Vision Support Barrow and District) catering specifically for children with a vision impairment. We are able to offer some advice over the phone and you can come into our main office in Kendal or to Barrow Vision Support as well.

There are three other sight loss charities in Cumbria covering Eden, Carlisle and West Cumbria who offer support to partially sighted and blind adults but may be able to advise you of other services local to you. However, as another option we have listed a range of resources that you can contact who may be able to support you and your child.

At your local hospital, there is an Eye Clinic Liaison Officer (ECLO) who will be able to give you some information about services that are available to you; currently Karen Townsend is the ECLO working across three hospitals in North Cumbria, Karen will have knowledge of services available in your area. Your local authority has a Qualified Teacher for Visually Impaired.
